SUBJECT: New Training Session Dates

You have been asked to be notified of upcoming training dates for the Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program. Successful completion of this training program fulfills the classroom component of the training required to work in the Onsite Wastewater Industry in BC. This program is also recognized in Alberta under the Trade, Investment and Labour Mobility Agreement (TILMA) and the New West Partnership, in Saskatchewan under the New West Partnership and in Manitoba under the Agreement on Internal Trade. Students will be required to complete an online training component prior to attending the classroom sessions.

The Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program is currently a nine day in-class course and a one-day field training class.

- You must complete all prerequisite training and nine days of classroom training with a passing grade of 75% in order to receive certification.
- You must also complete a mandatory Site and Soil Evaluation Field Training Day. This is the tenth day of training and will be scheduled throughout the installation season. Fees for the Site and Soil Evaluation Field Training Day are included in the tuition fees.

Your course supplies will be sent to you for review prior to training. **A minimum class of fifteen paid participants is required for the class to take place.**
